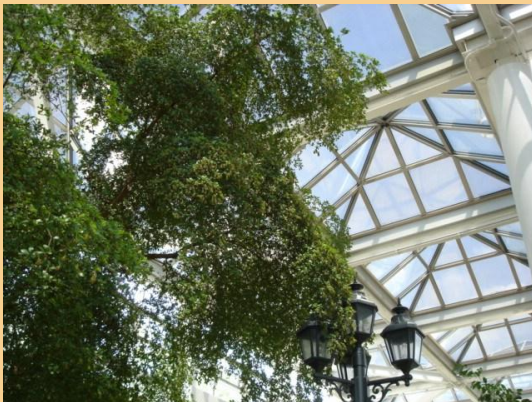
As you sit down to a Thanksgiving meal with family and friends this year, know that we are doing the same and giving thanks for YOU!

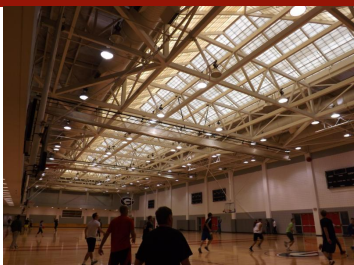


Taking A Look At Skylights
